

Welcome to Pocket Farm!

We're so glad you'll be joining us today and hope that you'll find what you're looking for. To help people, animals and plants stay healthy and safe during your visit, please review with your family the following rules of conduct for visitors to the farm. If you have any questions, don't hesitate to ask!

- 1) Please DO NOT go into the goat pen. The black one is a lovely goat but she makes a terrible person; she's not fond of children and will butt and even rear up. If a resident has time, we'd be happy to take you in to meet the goats (if you're an adult) or bring the little one out to meet you (if you're a kiddo).
- 2) Please DO NOT go into the chicken pens without a resident. When applicable, please DO NOT open the chick brooder without the supervision of a resident. With resident supervision, you're very welcome to pet, hold and feed the poultry – they're a lot of fun!
- 3) When you open a gate, please close it behind you. Many small children and all animals are escape artists – especially our three year old and our dog!
- 4) Please do not allow children to chase any animal or handle it without supervision.
- 5) Please do not allow children to harvest any fruit or veggie. They're welcome to climb trees, but they do so at their own risk. If the tree they'd like to climb has fruit or flowers on it, please help them find another tree.
- 6) To participate in any event at Pocket Farm, you will need to sign a waiver of liability that includes the name of each person attending.
