In California/Idaho/Minnesota / Rhode Island/New Mexico/ Arizona/Oklahoma/ Louisiana this could exempt reflexologist from the Massage law as long as the law is followed.</p> <p>* Exemption through a ruling by the Department of Health</p> <p>^ In Louisiana Reflexology is included in the cosmetology law. Other state's cosmetology laws have not been reviewed.</p> </div> <div> <p>Note:</p> <p>Massage Law. In order to practice legally in those states with a Massage law and no exemption, Reflexology is often licensed under Massage through the broad definition of Massage contained in the law. Reflexologists will need to check with the massage Board to determine if Reflexology is covered and abide accordingly.</p> </div> </div>
